Horse Creek Quarry Update

Horse Creek Quarry is L. G. Everist's latest greenfield site, and the Mountain Division's first hard rock quarry. The quarry is located approximately 30 miles northwest of Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Last year, a custom crushing subcontractor produced various products for us, which we have been selling since late 2024. Earlier this year, it was decided to switch gears and bring the production operation in-house. In August, a jaw, cone, and screen plant were procured. Additional equipment had to be purchased, and some idle equipment was repurposed from our sites across Mountain and Midwest divisions.

Another step in the process was kicking recruitment efforts into high gear and hiring new employees to operate the equipment. We are happy to have Sam Haddan return to LGE in the capacity of Plant Manager, and we welcome our new employees to the L. G. Everist family! The team is pictured above.

The last of the equipment arrived towards the end of September. Production commenced on October 6th. This was no easy feat, given the timeline. Many thanks go to everyone who was involved in making this project a success.

The plan is to run the plant at Horse Creek to supply enough inventory for the winter. To increase the utilization of the plant, the operation will move to our Colorado sites through the winter months. The equipment will then return to Horse Creek in the spring.
