Major Milestone in Fort Lupton

The Mountain Division reached an exciting milestone last month at our Fort Lupton operation. We officially broke ground on the new Fort Lupton Northeast property, and slurry wall construction is already underway, with mining set to begin soon. This transition is especially meaningful, as it marks our first move away from the “Fort Lupton Proper”

cells that have supported our work for more than two decades.

Preparing for this next chapter has taken tremendous effort across the team. Over the past year, we reclaimed more than 6,000 linear feet of high wall and moved over 1 million cubic yards of fill to fully close out our previous mining cells. Our goal has been to clean up and completely reclaim the three active cells from 2025 before shifting operations to the new site. Thanks to the dedication and hard work of our Fort Lupton crew, we are nearly there.

This progress reflects the collaboration of many departments and individuals. From the permitting of the property to the installation of more than 2,000 feet of conveyor to connect it, every step has required careful planning and teamwork. It has truly been a company-wide effort.

We’re proud of what has been accomplished so far, and every L. G. Everist team member involved should feel the same. Together, we’re laying the groundwork for the next era of success at Fort Lupton—and this milestone is only the beginning.
